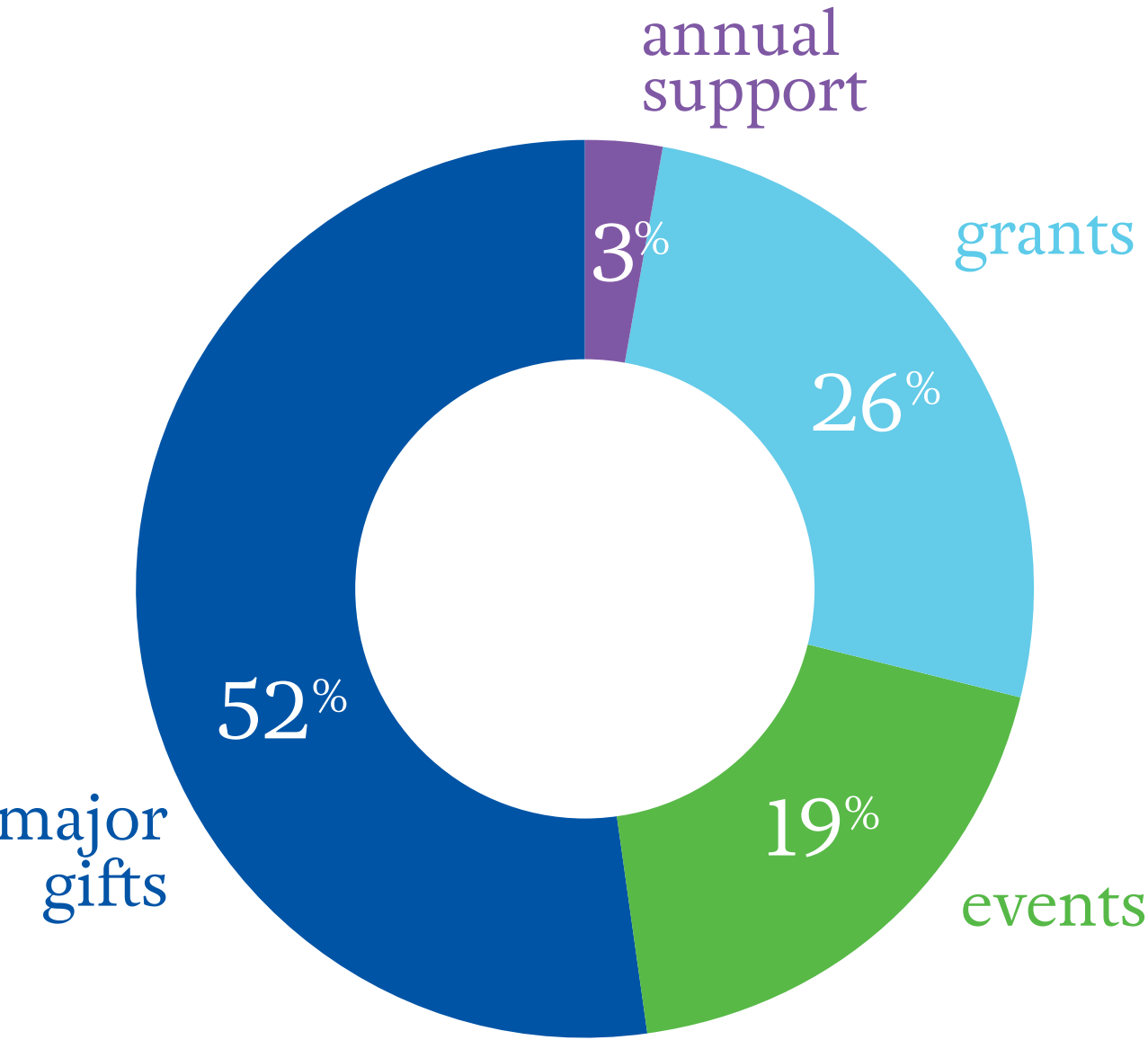

Barbara Marter

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE WELDON F. OSBORNE FOUNDATION

As the long-time leader of a local foundation, Barbara Marter is usually on the “giving” side of philanthropy. But after an unexpected health crisis, she is now a receiver of the generosity of CHI Memorial donors.

Barbara has served as the executive director of the Weldon F. Osborne Foundation since 2012.

She is also a patient at Memorial’s Martin Cardiac Amyloidosis Center of Excellence after being diagnosed with amyloidosis in January 2025.

The Weldon F. Osborne Foundation was one of many investors in the center, which opened in May 2025. It is named in honor of Dr. Henry Cheng, a cardiologist with the Chattanooga

Heart Institute and medical director of the amyloidosis program at Memorial. The center was funded in part through a \$2.5 million gift from Robert Martin, one of Dr. Cheng’s patients. Additional gifts were raised through Memorial’s \$21 million “Invest in the Best” campaign.

“I am a donor and a patient,” Barbara says. “After I was diagnosed, I told our trustees thank you for funding the center and I will use your money wisely. We got a return on our investment with that one!”

Cardiac amyloidosis is caused by abnormal proteins that build up in the heart muscle, making it stiff and weak. It can lead to heart failure, irregular heartbeat, and even sudden death if untreated.

Barbara’s diagnosis began with a different issue—carpal tunnel surgery on her hands. Her orthopedic surgeon, Dr. Robert Mastey, was testing his patients for amyloidosis in a cooperative study with Dr. Cheng, building on Dr. Cheng’s efforts to pioneer community amyloid screening.

Barbara tested positive for the abnormal protein after a biopsy on her right hand. Dr. Mastey referred her to Dr. Cheng. Further testing showed she has a non-genetic form of amyloidosis and revealed one small spot of the protein on the back of her heart.

“I wasn’t initially concerned, because my faith leads me,” Barbara says. But after researching the condition, she understood its consequences and the urgency for treatment.

“Dr. Cheng told me if I had not had carpal tunnel surgery and been tested for the protein, my life expectancy was only two to three years,” Barbara explains. “It’s like God said, ‘I’m going to let you have this (carpal tunnel) because I have something else for you to do; I’m not done with you yet.’ It was a God wink. God was saying I’m going to take care of it.”

Treatment consists of shots to slow or actually stop production of the protein and large

doses of vitamin A to counter its effects. With treatment, Barbara can expect to live 10 to 15 additional years.

A drug to reverse amyloidosis is being developed and is expected to be released in three to four years. Barbara expects to take advantage of this new treatment.

The long-time philanthropist praises Dr. Cheng and his staff. “I love his bedside personality and he explains things in laymen’s terms,” she says. “His staff is so friendly and they act like they’ve known you for years.”

Today, the 71-year-old has no side effects from her treatments. She still works full-time and enjoys yard work and gardening. She plans to retire next year and devote her time to travel and assisting area non-profits with training through the Nonprofit Resource Center.

Barbara has a passion to share her experiences with others and encourages everyone to be tested for amyloidosis. For more information about cardiac amyloidosis or screening for the disease, call the Chattanooga Heart Institute at (423) 697-2000.

The gala was a testament to the unwavering support of our community, raising an incredible \$1,065,865 for the MaryEllen Locher Breast Center. The sold-out event, attended by 1,100 dedicated supporters, brought the total raised over the past two decades to over \$8.2 million.

These vital funds will directly impact the lives of women and families in our region. Specifically, Pink! proceeds will fund: a new stereotactic biopsy table for the Hixson location, enhancing diagnostic capabilities; two new 3D mammography machines, ensuring access to the latest in breast cancer screening technology; expanded access to mammography for underserved populations; care for uninsured patients or those struggling to afford treatment; scholarships for children who have a parent with breast cancer; and growth of the MaryEllen Locher Breast Center Endowment, securing the future of breast health care in our community.

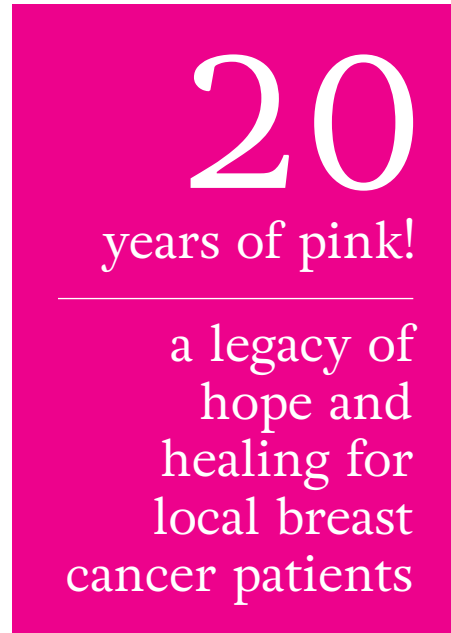

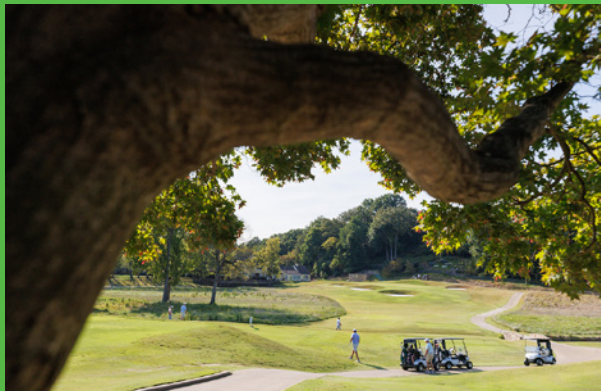

MaryEllen Locher scholarship fund AND MEL’S CLUB



The MaryEllen Locher Scholarship Fund at CHI Memorial Foundation continues to be a beacon of hope for Chattanooga-area students impacted by breast cancer.

In the 2023-24 academic year, the fund awarded 31 college scholarships totaling \$93,000, providing crucial financial assistance to students who have lost a parent to breast cancer, have a parent who is a survivor, or have a parent currently undergoing treatment. Founded in 2002 by the late MaryEllen Locher, a beloved news anchor and health reporter, the fund joined CHI Memorial Foundation in 2021, amplifying its reach and impact.

Driven by MaryEllen’s own experience battling breast cancer and her desire to alleviate the educational concerns of families facing similar challenges, the fund has awarded nearly 660 scholarships totaling over \$1.3 million in its 23-year history. These awards are designed to ease the emotional and financial burdens faced by families dealing with breast cancer, ensuring that students can pursue their educational dreams without the added stress of financial hardship.

We extend our deepest gratitude to the generous donors who make this vital scholarship fund possible, allowing us to honor MaryEllen’s legacy and support the next generation of leaders.

“Mel’s Club” is the educational component of the MaryEllen Locher Scholarship Fund. Launched in 2014, Mel’s Club has educated thousands of girls in area schools on the importance of breast health beginning at an early age. Mel’s Club equips students in three key areas: myths and misconceptions regarding breast cancer; facts, warning signs and prevention; and tools and training in how to do a breast self-exam. A breast cancer survivor also shares her story. Participants receive a packet of information to take home and share with other women in their family.

EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT CHAPLAIN

Adrien Edoo is familiar with emergency departments—both as a patient and now as a CHI Memorial chaplain.

Like many patients he serves as Memorial's Emergency Department chaplain, Adrien knows what it's like to fight for his life. After a near-fatal car crash in January 2024, he suffered a traumatic

brain injury. He has no memory of the accident or his recovery, and had to learn to walk and talk again. His own trauma gives him a hard-earned compassion for others in crisis.

"I've done lots of other ministry before, but work in the ED touches me in a very different way," Adrien says. "We are in the trials and tribulations

of life with others. We are in the deepest, darkest moments with people. This is where I want to be. I am called to life here."

The 38-year-old is a native of Trinidad and Tobago. He earned bachelor's and master's degrees there in chemistry, environmental management, and environmental engineering. He came to the United States at age 32 and earned a master's degree in theology from the Pentecostal Theological Seminary in Cleveland, Tennessee.

After seminary, Adrien completed a year-long chaplain residency at Memorial. He worked as a chaplain at Emory University Hospital in Atlanta, but left the job after his accident to return to his home country and recover.

While there, Adrien received a call from Bill Hawkins, Memorial's clinical pastoral education educator. Bill encouraged him to apply for a new position at the hospital, ED chaplain. He was hired and started work in November 2024.

Adrien says he knew his calling in life was hospital chaplaincy after completing Memorial's residency program. "I fell in love with it—and with Memorial," he says. "I find a sense of home here. There's something special about how we do things here at the hospital."

Chaplains work closely with clinical staff to meet all needs of patients, Adrien explains.

"Doctors and nurses focus on the physical health of patients," he says. "As chaplains, we are here to offer support and ease any distress the patient may have, whether it's regarding their physical suffering or spiritual, mental, emotional, relational, and financial concerns."

Chaplains also focus on the needs of patients' family members. "Sometimes the patients can be fine," Adrien says. "They are very sick, but they are in a good place. But the family members are not."

Adrien also enjoys ministering to hospital staff members because "the caregivers need care too. These are the people who are constants in my life—my family and friends," he says. "When they have difficulties from the job or their personal

lives, you can sense that. You can offer care, compassion, and comfort."

The work of an ED chaplain differs from caring for patients in other units, Adrien maintains.

"Patients in other units tend to know what their problem is," he says. "In the ED, patients often don't know it yet. They come in with more anxiety, nerves, and fear. We can offer a sense of comfort, care, love, and support in these early stages. This sets the tone for what will happen afterwards with the patient."

Asked to describe his "life verse" for ministry, Adrian says that after his accident, he identified with Job, a Biblical figure known for his response to suffering. He recalls Job 42:5—"I had heard of you by the hearing of the ear, but now my eye sees you."

"Job is a special guy," Adrien says. "In the midst of his losses, he wasn't driven further from God. The process didn't look pretty. But he had heard of God and he was living obediently and doing everything right. Now, in the midst of suffering, he SEES God, and he becomes more intimate with Him."

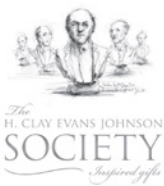
Adrien's position in the ED was funded through a gift to Memorial's "Invest in the Best" campaign. He is grateful for the impact of those who support the hospital financially.

"They have given me so much," Adrien says. "They give me hope and a place where I can fulfill my calling and my passion. I can do something that I love, around people that I love."

Pam Lawson has been a part of CHI Memorial Georgia's past and present for 52 years. At 78, she is excited to move forward into the future as the new Georgia campus opens later this year.

Pam has been a part of the Battlefield Parkway vision from the beginning. "I remember when

we bought the land down there," she says. "It's like a dream come true. I look forward to walking into the new hospital and saying, 'I was here when this all started.' I can't wait to see it when they give us the keys!"

Pam's current role is medical staff coordinator. As a full-time quality department employee,

she confirms physician credentialing for new hires, checking on licensing, references, and educational background. She hopes to continue in this role when the new campus opens.

Pam joined Hutcheson Medical Center (now CHI Memorial Georgia) after 10 years with a Chattanooga health care facility. She began her career there as a cash receipts clerk. After other positions in hospital finance, she became the assistant to the chief operating officer. She spent 25 years working as executive assistant to the hospital president/CEO. She worked with 11 different leaders during her years as executive assistant.

The veteran employee saw expansive growth at Hutcheson over the years, including the addition of a women's center, new physicians' offices, sub-acute specialties on the campus, and additional beds. "When I first came to work here, we would average 282 patients a day," Pam says.

When the Hutcheson property was leased by CHI Memorial in 2017, Pam welcomed the resulting changes. "We always had great care, but Memorial put even more emphasis on quality of patient care," she says.

Pam also embraced the continued emphasis on faith-based care, which had always been a tradition at Hutcheson.

"As Memorial employees, we try to show people our beliefs and share our faith," she says.

As a three-time cancer survivor, Pam has personally experienced Memorial's high standards of care and commitment to faith-based healing. She has been diagnosed with melanoma, breast cancer, and non-Hodgkins lymphoma.

Pam treasures her friendships with staff and clinical professionals at the Georgia campus, who walked with her through diagnosis, surgeries, and treatments.

"There were days when I was so sick from chemo and radiation," she recalls. "But everyone was so good to me, checking on me and making

sure I was okay. All my friends and co-workers prayed for me. And I never missed a day's work the whole time I was taking treatments."

The new Georgia campus is funded in part through the \$5 million "Care Closer to Home" campaign, spearheaded by the CHI Memorial Foundation. Pam appreciates the generosity of donors.

"It will be so appreciated and it's so needed," she says. "This will change health care in our community."

Pam attended the ground-breaking for the new campus—and now she is ready for the blessing ceremony when it opens.

"I will probably cry when I leave our old building," she says. "And I will cry when I walk into the new one. We have so much to look forward to. I hope everyone will enjoy it as much as I think they will."

Memorial volunteer & auxiliary services

Volunteers are often the first to reach out to welcome a patient or visitor to our campuses as shuttle drivers or at information desks. They also share gifts of music, pet therapy, business skills, and friendship. Effort is made for each to serve where they find joy.

The Auxiliary raises funds to enhance patient care in addition to their hours of service. Many volunteers donate personally to the Foundation.
